PMH Pharmacy & Meds

Please be aware that you cannot pre-order online anymore. PMH Pharmacy has changed pre-ordering of meds. You must get the hospital script scanned/emailed (or take a photo) through with your child's name, hospital number, quantity required and pick up date:

Did you know that Tacrolimus now comes under the PBS and you should be able to get a script from your GP. Please check with your GP so you can get your local Pharmacy to dispense. They will have to order in but should only take about 1-2 days.
