






Schedule














Approximate cost for participation

Registration for athletes and supporters: \$US1,100 (includes seven nights accommodation, all sports, all meals including breakfast, lunch, dinner and gala dinner and transfers from the airport and during the Games to all events)

Travel: estimated cost of Air Fares with a night stopover via Singapore: \$AUD2,300.00

Uniform (Approximate cost of basic uniform):

Tracksuit - \$120 Athlete polo - \$ 50

Shorts and athlete singlet can also be purchased.

Supporters can also purchase the tracksuit and a supporter polo for the same cost as indicated above.

Uniform requirements for opening parade:

Dress Polo - \$50 Blazer - \$220

Akubra Hat - Ranging from \$30 to \$100
