

Transplant Australia is a national charity representing transplant recipients, donor families, living donors and all those touched by organ and tissue donation and transplantation. A primary focus of the organisation is to raise awareness of the need to **increase organ donor rates in Australia**. **Transplant Australia** is responsible for staging the **Australian Transplant Games** as well as looking after the interests of all its members through advocacy, raising awareness and support.

Transplant Australia is inviting submissions to their **art exhibition and online auction**. Funds raised will support the work of **Transplant Australia** and enable more children with organ transplants to attend future **Australian Transplant Games**.

All works submitted must be available for auction and prior to the auction works will firstly be exhibited at the Art Space Collective (80A Scarborough Beach Rd, Scarborough WA). **An Exhibition Opening will be held at 3pm Sunday 26th August** and the exhibition will be open to the public from 26 - 31tst Aug between 10am and 2pm daily. Thereafter, the exhibition will be displayed at the **Australian Transplant Games** on the Gold Coast (30 Sept - 6 Oct 2018). The online auction will take place after the Games and at the completion of the auction any unsold works will be available for purchase by private negotiation.

conditions of entry

1. All artworks must be the original work of the artist.

2. Art works will be postcard size i.e. no bigger than 15cm x 11cm. They will be unmounted/ unframed. In the event of the image being on a sheet substantially larger than the maximum postcard size the organisers reserve the right to sensitively trim the sheet for display.

3. The title/edition of the work is to be written on back or front in pencil only. On the back, in pencil only, give artist's name and indicate which way is up by marking a 'T' for the top. A brief sentence about the artist should also be included in pencil on the reverse.

4. Entries must be accompanied by the separate entry form sheet giving artist's name, plus parent or guardian's name where appropriate, a contact email and mobile number and agreement to the conditions of entry.

5. Artwork will ideally be accompanied by a short background statement about the artist. This is not compulsory but will be provenance supplied to a buyer on collection.

6. It is the responsibility of the artist (or their parents or guardians) to ensure their work is not subject to defamation or does not violate any copyright laws.

7. Transplant Australia reserves the right to reject works that could be considered offensive and/or contrary to the spirit of the organisation.



8. Placement of works within the exhibition will be at the discretion of the Transplant Australia organisers.

9. Prizes will only be awarded to those children (under 18) who raise the most funds from their art and will be announced on the Transplant Australia website at transplant.org.au

10. All artists submitting agree to allow their works to be used by Transplant Australia for future posters and promotional campaigns. Copyright remains the property of the artist and in the event of a work being used by Transplant Australia for promotional purposes the artist will be notified and acknowledged.

11. All reasonable care will be taken, however Transplant Australia will not accept responsibility for damage, loss, fire, theft or vandalism.

12. Artists will be notified by email when their work is sold and a list of all artworks sold by online auction and/or private negotiation will be published on the Transplant Australia website by 1st December 2018.

13. Works unsold by the end of December will be available for return.
