Currently there are 1800 Australians waiting for a life-saving transplant and another 13,000 on kidney dialysis who may benefit from transplantation.

Some must wait years and sadly others will never receive the chance. Living kidney donation from a loved one or friend or even an unconnected person (through the paired kidney exchange program), is one of life's greatest gifts. However, Australia's rate of living donations has decreased significantly over the past 10 years. Of course, living donations only applies to kidney donations. Deceased donors enable other life-saving transplants including heart, lung, kidney, cornea, and liver transplants.

Brett & Jodie Barton and their family are living this experience.

When Jodie required a kidney transplant, she was grateful to have five generous people who were willing to undergo the testing process to be a kidney donor. After twelve months of extensive testing, Brett was selected as a suitable donor and Jodie underwent a successful kidney transplant.

Unfortunately, further health complications related to her condition has meant that Jodie has now been waitlisted to receive a liver transplant. Jodie is one of the 1800 Australians waiting a life-saving transplant and we are hoping that special call will happen this year.

Last year we raised \$97,500 which was shared between Transplant Australia and the North Foundation and put towards developing programs for potential living kidney donors and recipients, as well as helping those on dialysis awaiting a transplant. A memorial garden was also established at Royal North Shore Hospital to thank those who made transplantation possible over the last 40 years. This year our target is to go beyond this and support continued education so more Australians will consider being a living donor or registering to be a donor.
